INTRODUCING SLVM

SLVM provides access to a global basket of silver miners which stand to benefit from rising silver prices and being a key part of the value chain facilitating growth in photovoltaics, advanced electronics and more. SLVM seeks to provide investment results that correspond generally to the price and yield performance, before fees and expenses, of the Solactive Global Silver Miners Net Total Return AUD Index.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Silver is the most reflective metal on Earth, reflecting over 95% of visible light. This property makes it a critical material in photovoltaic solar panels, where silver-based conductive pastes maximise light capture and electrical efficiency.
- Most silver is produced as a by-product of mining for copper, lead, zinc, and gold, meaning supply is relatively insensitive to silver prices.
- Silver occupies a rare position as both a monetary asset and an industrial input. Today, more than half of annual silver demand comes from industrial uses such as electronics, semiconductors, medical equipment, and energy infrastructure.

Operating Leverage Effect

Silver miners may offer greater upside participation through operating leverage, with miners benefiting as higher price levels improve profitability and project viability.



Era of Supply Deficits

Silver's chronic supply deficit since 2021 highlights the challenges of scaling production and could provide further upside as demand continues to outstrip supply.



Growing Industrial Demand

Silver's increased industrial usage, including in photovoltaics, grid expansion and semiconductor manufacturing, has reshaped investor perceptions and underpins a more structural, long-term investment case.

HOW TO USE SLVM IN A PORTFOLIO

- To express a short to medium term view on the price movements of silver and take advantage of the effects of operating leverage.
- As an indirect exposure to the growing long-term demand for silver as a crucial commodity across a range of growing industries.

HOW SLVM WORKS

The Solactive Global Silver Miners Net Total Return AUD Index includes silver-focused mining companies listed in Developed or Emerging Markets (excluding China, India, and Taiwan) that meet minimum free-float market capitalisation and liquidity thresholds. Eligible securities must demonstrate sufficient trading activity and, for IPOs, a minimum trading history. Index constituents are selected and ranked by average daily trading value, with the 20-40 most liquid companies included.
